Dear Councillors

I wish to express my strong objection to Development Proposal DA2023/0130 which seeks to demolish existing buildings and construct and operate an organic waste transfer station on 109A Church Street Lidcombe NSW 2141. This project will have an enormous effect on the residents and the ecological balance of the neighbourhood. This project will see the traffic on Church Street becoming even more congested than it already is due to the increase in the number of residents in the newly constructed apartments. If this project goes ahead, it means heavy vehicle traffic will result in slower travelling times causing a huge inconvenience to residents. This project will consequently lead to bad odour emanating from the waste station and heightened noise which will significantly affect the health of the residents.

In light of that, I urge the Council to kindly re-evaluate this proposal and its consequences taking into consideration the well-being of the residents and the protection of our wildlife.
