Cumberland Local Council has received a proposal to build a rubbish tip (Organic Waste Transfer Station on 109A Church Street Lidcombe) (DA2023/0130) which is less than 100 metres away from our local residential properties, schools, Child Care, Aged Care, Parks and Businesses.

The proposed operational times are every Monday to Friday from 6:00 am to 10:00 pm, from 8:00 am to 6:00 pm on Saturday. 59 large garbage trucks with a length of 20 metres will enter and exit from our Lidcombe streets, resulting 118 truck movements every day.

If the waste transfer station gets built, this would have significant impact on the residents currently living near the proposed construction site and rest of the neighbourhood with:

1. Traffic congestion
2. Air, noise and soil pollution
3. Dust fumes and bad smell
4. Negatively impact the tranquillity of our suburb
5. Negatively impact the health and safety of local residents
6. Negatively impact property values
7. Negatively affect residential, commercial and recreational environment
8. Local residents will bear the cost of roadworks damaged by the ongoing heavy vehicle usage of the area.
