It has come to my attention that the Cumberland Local Council is proposing to build a rubbish tip in Lidcombe. I'm sending this email to urge the Council to repeal the proposal as this will significantly impact the residents of Lidcombe.

The site of the rubbish tip will be placed no further than 100 meters of local homes. Along with air pollution and bad fumes, residents near the site will have to bear the sounds of rubbish trucks driving in and out of the site. Thus, negatively impacting the overall well-being of the residents.

Additionally, due to the number of apartments being built, Lidcombe's population is increasing at a rapid rate. This has resulted in more vehicles on the roads of Lidcombe. An organic waste transfer station will result in over 50 garbage trucks driving through the streets of Lidcombe every weekday, thus congesting our roads even more.

Furthermore, property values in Lidcombe have risen over the last decade. However the proposed construction of the rubbish tip would push away potential homebuyers. Thus, leading to decreased values of homes in Lidcombe.
