My name is _____ I live on _____ I am a local resident and am not an expert in waste management, city planning nor am in any position to provide expert advice or opinion.

I am writing to express my discontent with the proposed works at this site to build an Organic Waste Transfer Station. I am supportive of transfer stations due to the immense benefit they have on our waste management as a whole, however my opinion is that that the proposed site is appropriate for one. Mainly because the area is **not industrial**, with residential houses very close by – not to mentioned the almost finished set of apartments along Church St towards Lidcombe Station. A successful transfer station to operate efficiently around residential properties will have to managed extremely efficiently as to not cause problems with the local community, especially when it comes to traffic, let alone odour, noise, air pollution, etc. We are already expecting road congestion to be around Church St, and the Church St – Railway St Intersection to pick up as a result of the increased residential community. I do not have faith that a transfer station in the proposed site will be managed well enough to not cause problems to the direct community.

If we were to build a transfer station, I think a more appropriate location would be within the Chullora Industrial precinct.
