My name is _____ I would like to object to the construction and operation of an organic waste transfer station at 109A Church Street LIDCOMBE NSW 2141; Lot 1 DP 778492. File: DA2023/0130.

I am concerned about the impact that the construction and operation of this facility will have on the immediate and surrounding areas of Lidcombe in the form of:

- Noise and air pollution from the increased truck movements to and from the waste transfer station
- The smell that can and will emanate from this plant. Given past experiences living near to recycling plants the foul smells that will come from this waste transfer station will cause residents in the surrounding area to suffer both in health and safety.
- Traffic congestion will increase greatly as 109A Church Street LIDCOMBE NSW 2141 and the roads nearby are all 2 lane roads. Constant flow of large garbage trucks will block up traffic all around the waste transfer station. It will also be a pedestrian hazards as trucks are driving to and from the facility.
